Romans 12:9-21 | *will be preached on April 21, 2024*

1. There are nearly 30 distinct commands in this short section! Can you find any common threads or unifying themes that link them together?
2. Which of these commands strikes you as the most challenging, most difficult, or most relevant?
3. As in the parallel passage in 1 Corinthians 12:27-13:3, God calls us to use our spiritual gifts (Romans 12:6-8) and then reminds us of the importance of love (Romans 12:9-10). Why does Paul put such an emphasis on love?
4. Think of a concrete situation in your life in which you could apply Romans 12:21: "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."
5. In light of the truth in this passage, how can others pray for you?
