Romans 11:1-10 | *will be preached on March 3, 2024*

1. One theologian summarizes Romans 9-11 in this way: Chapter 9: Israel's Fall; Chapter 10: Israel's Fault; Chapter 11: Israel's Future. Read through chapter 11 and make a note of any passage that speaks about Israel's future.

2. In the midst of Israel's widespread rejection of the gospel, what evidences of God's grace does Paul want us to see?

3. In what ways does this passage highlight God's sovereignty in salvation?

4. In what ways does this passage apply to our lives today? (*Think about actions, attitudes, affections, and truths to be believed.*)

5. In light of the truth in this passage, how can others pray for you?
