1. Verse 5 begins with the word "for". How do you understand the flow of thought between the passage last week and this new paragraph?

2. Paul quotes several Old Testament passages in this paragraph: Deuteronomy 30:11-14, Isaiah 28:16, and Joel 2:32. Pick one of those passages and read it in its context. What insights does this give you into Paul's train of thought?

3. One of Paul's themes throughout the book is "no distinction between Jew and Greek" (10:11). Consider 1:16, 2:9-10, 3:22. How does Paul's statement in chapter 10 fit with his earlier points?

4. How does this passage apply to our lives in the way we think about other people?

5. In light of the truth in this passage, how can others pray for you?
