



# Romans Bible Study Questions

Romans 9:30-10:4 | *will be preached on February 4, 2024*

1. In vv. 30-33, Paul makes a contrast between the Gentiles and Israel. What's the central idea? How might this apply to our lives today?

2. In 9:1-5 and in 10:1-4, Paul shares his heart for the Jewish people. How is this an example for us to follow?

3. In v. 4 Paul says that "Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes." In light of the surrounding context, how do you understand what Paul is saying? *You may want to look back to chapter 6 and 7.*

4. How could you be in danger of "stumbling over the stumbling stone" (9:32)? What about our church? Your non-Christian family or friends?

5. In light of the truth in this passage, how can others pray for you?
