Romans 14:1-12 | *will be preached on May 19, 2024*

1. The church in Rome was a mixture of Gentile believers and Jewish believers. According to this passage what were some of the issues that made it difficult for them to get along? What are some issues that make it difficult for us to get along?

2. This section has three paragraphs: 1-4, 5-9, 10-12. In the first and third paragraphs Paul addresses the problem of *judging your brother*. What kind of judging does Paul have in mind?

3. Why is it wrong for Christians to “pass judgment... or despise your brother”?

4. Think about verses 7 and 8. What are some areas of your life where it is difficult to live this out? What kind of changes is God convicting you to make?

5. In light of the truth in this passage, how can others pray for you?
