Romans 11:11-24 | *will be preached on March 10, 2024*

1. The church in Rome was a mixture of Jews and Gentiles. But here Paul has a special message for the Gentiles. What is it? Why do they need to know this?

2. Paul weaves in an illustration about an olive tree throughout this passage. How does that illustration work? What is the big idea (or ideas) he is trying to communicate?

3. What does this passage teach us about God?

4. One commentator summarizes this section: "Israel's fall was neither *total* nor *final*." Why would this truth have mattered to the original audience? Why does it matter to us today?

5. In light of the truth in this passage, how can others pray for you?
