



# James Bible Study Questions

James 3:13-18 || *will be preached on October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023*

1. What does our culture count as "wisdom" or "wise"? How is this *like* or *unlike* the definition that James provides?
2. James puts particular emphasis on the sins of "jealousy" and "selfish ambition". What does it mean (or look like) to be guided by these motives?
3. How does the final sentence (v. 18) relate to the section as a whole?
4. What is God showing me about myself? What have you seen about yourself by looking in the mirror of his word (James 1:22-25)?
5. In light of the truth in this passage, how can others pray for you?
